2009 “ISIS VINEYARD” VIOGNIER

An emerging variety sourced by Jane Brook for its aromatic uniqueness from Isis Vineyard in Chittering Valley.



WINEMAKING / VITICULTURE :

The 2009 “Isis Vineyard” Viognier displays attractive lifted characters of orange blossom, pear & musk on the nose.

The palate is viscous & juicy with great body, balanced acidity, fresh finish & generous length of flavour including candied apricot and pear. Complexity has been added through 35% barrel fermentation in French oak.

The Viognier block was harvested in two lots to increase complexity, structure and flavour profile. After crushing & pressing, the clarified juice was fermented at 12-16°C in stainless steel & French oak.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS :

The 2009 vintage in Perth Hills was late with moderate ripening conditions. In the white wines, good, natural, refreshing acidity was experienced which has resulted in sensational wines.
